



## **INTERNSHIP OPPORTUNITY SUMMER 09 with UNIVERSITY OF PUERTO RICO**

The URI Transportation Center is offering a research internship opportunity at the University of Puerto Rico at Mayagüez for summer 2009. This program is sponsored by the Federal Highway Administration Dwight D. Eisenhower Fellowship Program, and aims to promote instruction and research in the transportation field.

The internship will be 7 - 8 weeks in duration (beginning of June to the end of July). Undergraduate participants will receive a stipend of approximately \$1,450/month, and graduate students will receive \$1,700/month. In addition, housing and the round-trip airfare will be covered.

### Requirements:

Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 in an Engineering field. Knowledge of Spanish is beneficial, but not necessary. Students should be comfortable with living and experiencing a different cultural environment. An interest in transportation-related topics is preferable, but not necessary.
